



2018 Park Pass Information

The City of Grosse Pointe Woods is implementing a new element to the park pass system in an effort to increase safety for residents using Lake Front Park. A digital photo will be linked to every park pass issued beginning January 2018. When your new pass is scanned at the park gate, your photo will pop up on the computer screen, helping to ensure park staff that the pass is, in fact, registered to the person using it. The photo will not appear on the pass itself until 2019.

The current park pass scanning software already includes the photo feature, so there are minimal costs associated with this addition to the park passes. New photos will be taken only every 3-5 years. Grosse Pointe Woods is the second of the Pointes to include resident photos on park passes. Grosse Pointe City started issuing park passes with resident photos in 2006

To accommodate residents in a timely manner, park pass applications submitted online and via the city hall drop box will be processed prior to pick up. Photos will be taken as residents come to the Community Center to retrieve them. The office hours are Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.; however Community Center staff is able to process applications during evening and weekend hours when the center is hosting classes or building rentals.
