Jocelyn Benson	Mike Cox	This millage would replace an expiring millage levied by the Wayne County Transit Authority supporting the Suburban Mobility Authority for Regional Transportation ("SMART").
Congressional	John James	If this new millage is approved and levied, revenue will be distributed to Wayne County, SMART, Detroit Department of Transportation (DDOT), and other community and regional transit providers. It is estimated that \$57,616,329.00 will be collected in the first year.
