It is understood that the license applied for will be granted only after approval by the Director of Public Works, and the filing of a Performance Bond in the amount of Two Thousand Dollar (\$2,000.00). The license issued shall expire on December 31 of the year issued. The license fee of \$50.00 is to be paid at the time of issuance.

IF GRANTED, THE APPLICANT ACKNOWLEDGES THAT ANY LICENSE ISSUED BY THE CITY WILL CONTAIN A CONDITION THAT TREE TRIMMERS MAY NOT USE SPURS, SPIKES, OR GAFTS, BECAUSE THEY CAUSE IRREPARABLE DAMAGE TO THE TREES. THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL ONLY BE USED IN THE REMOVAL OF TREES.

DIVISION 2. - LICENSE

Sec. 10-632. - Required.

No person shall operate a tree trimming or tree removal service within the city without first obtaining a license to conduct such service from the city clerk.

Sec. 10-633. - Application.

Any person desiring a license under the terms of this article shall make application for such license to the city clerk on forms provided. Each application shall be referred to the director of public services for the director's approval prior to the issuance of a license by the city clerk. The director of public services may withhold approval of an application if the applicant has been found guilty or pleaded guilty or no contest to a charge of violation of this Code concerning the removal and disposal of tree trimmings or stumps.

Sec. 10-634. - Fee; performance bond.

Upon approval of the application for a license under this article, the applicant shall pay the sum as currently established or as hereafter adopted by resolution of the city council from time to time as a license fee to the city and shall file a performance bond in the amount as currently established or as hereafter adopted by resolution of the city council from time to time with the city to guarantee that the licensee shall remove and dispose of tree trimmings, bush trimmings and stumps cut by such licensee from the premises whereat such services were performed.

Sec. 10-635. - Display.

The applicant shall receive from the city clerk a license plate evidencing the fact that a license has been issued under the terms of this article. Such license plate shall be posted on the left side of any motor vehicle operated in connection with the applicant's business in a conspicuous location. If the applicant uses more than one motor vehicle, additional license plates will be furnished to the applicant at a charge as currently established or as hereafter adopted by resolution of the city council from time to time.
