- Council approved the Beautification Commission to purchase 500 seedlings for the 2012 Arbor Day Tree Seedling in an amount not to exceed \$500.
- Site plan approval for schools was discussed. Council Member Sucher briefly commented on the MML's support that site plan approvals of schools should remain with local authority enabling municipalities to enforce local zoning ordinances.
- School of Choice legislation was discussed. Council Member Granger informed the Council that the Senate Education Committee will have a televised meeting next Wednesday. She will relay the information to the Clerk to disperse when details become available.
- Proposed Redistricting was discussed. Council member Granger informed the Council that the League of Women Voters will be holding a meeting on Wednesday at the War Memorial at 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of discussing proposed redistricting.

- Wayne County Collection of Delinquent Taxes was discussed. Council directed the Attorney to:
  - Contact the County Treasurer's Office to discuss the proposed course of action regarding foreclosed properties that are purchased for back taxes.
  - Check state statutes to see if it is legal for property to revert to local municipality if the owner does not follow the guidelines agreed to at the purchase.
  - What ramifications will the proposed course of action have on the City?
