Item 9A PURCHASE – ANNUAL FUEL The Director of Public Works has been communicating with the City of Sterling Heights regarding piggybacking onto the tri-county cooperative fuel bid contract for the period of February 1, 2006, through January 31, 2008. The tri-county cooperative fuel bid prices are lower than the State program at a cost of \$.50 less than current consumer pump prices. The Sterling Heights City Council extended the cooperative contract to the low bidder, Atlas Oil Company, Taylor, MI. The Director of Public Works is recommending awarding this contract with Atlas Oil through the Tri-county cooperative program as they have supplied the City with satisfactory service since February 1, 2000.

Prerogative of the City Council to concur with the Director of Public Works and award a contract to Atlas Oil Co. for tank wagon deliveries of the City's unleaded and diesel fuel purchases from February 1, 2006, through January 31, 2008.
