Public Safety Patrol Vehicles Extended Service Plan

Per your direction, in reviewing different options and deductibles for extended service plans, I believe the following plan best meets the needs of the Public Safety Department:

BaseCARE Extended Service Plan: 3 years/100,000 miles with a \$100.00 deductible. This plan covers parts and labor to repair 84 major components – after the Bumper-to-Bumper New Vehicle Limited Warranty expires.

BaseCARE includes eight major vehicle systems:

- > Engine
- > Transmission
- ➤ Brake system
- > Air conditioning and heating system
- > Rear-wheel-drive components
- > Electrical systems
- Suspension systems

This plan will cost \$1,275.00 per vehicle or \$8,925.00. This additional cost must be paid when we purchase the vehicles. Having this plan will address many of the out-of-warranty issues experienced over the last several years.

The purchase amount of \$8,925.00 is not a budgeted item in the current 2010-2011 budget. However, this amount is available through General Fund fund balance [101-000-694.000].

Council approval required

There was a consensus of the Committee in favor of purchasing seven new Crown Victoria vehicles in solid black.

The City Administrator was asked to provide the Committee with a recommendation on extended maintenance warranty, including costs, in preparation for the City Council Meeting on January 3, 2011.

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
