Subject: Flood Action Items	

The below is list of action items being taken as well as for consideration as a result of the recent flooding issue. Please note that #1-3 are already included in the FY 21/22 budget.

- 1. Televise Sewers:
 - a. The areas around Torrey Road and Ida Lane will be the first to be televised to check their conditions (\$220,000.00);
- 2. Sewer Lining Project:
 - a. City wide sewer repair program by using cured-in-place pipe lining techniques (\$300,000.00);
- 3. Open Cut/Pipe Burst Sewer Repairs:
 - a. Starting in August (600,000.00):
 - i. Total of prefunded programs is \$1,020,000.00. This was budgeted for and planned this past spring prior to any flooding;
- 4. Televise and investigate individual properties reporting flooding;
- 5. Obtaining and reviewing the data from *Southeast Macomb Sanitary District* at *Milk Rive*r as a result of the flood events;
- 6. Study the feasibility and cost of installing water level sensors and water flow meters in existing sewer lines;
- 7. Study feasibility of alternatives to diverting the Harper Woods drainage water from *Torrey Road Pump Station* and into the *Black Marsh Drain*;
- 8. Obtained estimates to install back flow prevention valves in resident's homes:
 - a. 6,700 homes at \$2,000 per home will cost approximately \$13,400,000.00;
 - b. 6,700 homes at \$2,500 per home will cost approximately \$16,750,000.00.
- 9. Working with regional partners to facilitate a regional water study program.
