

## **MEMORANDUM**

**SUBJECT:** Federal Aid Projects

At the Wayne County Federal Aid Committee meeting we attended on Wednesday, June 26, the City of Grosse Pointe Woods was approved for Federal Aid funding for a total amount of \$858,000 (see attached excerpt). The roads for which the City had applied for this funding included Marter Road (Vernier to North City Limit), Morningside Road (Lochmoor to south of Renaud) and Vernier Road (Charlevoix to Fairway). Federal Aid will cover 81.15% of the construction cost. The total cost to the City (18.85% of construction cost and design and construction engineering) is estimated at \$400,000.

The proposed work on these streets includes concrete patching and resurfacing. This is a cost effective treatment for which there is a limited window of time to apply. If the roads deteriorate further the recommended treatment would become reconstruction, which is more costly and disruptive to the residents and motoring public.

The amount of funding approved by the Federal Aid Committee is measurably less than we had estimated was needed (original submittal attached). Based on our discussion, it is anticipated work on Marter and Morningside will take priority and there will likely not be enough funding to include work on Vernier.


