MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE CONSTRUCTION COMMITTEE, OF THE CITY OF GROSSE POINTE WOODS, HELD ON MONDAY, JUNE 13, 2011, IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 20025 MACK PLAZA, GROSSE POINTE WOODS, MICHIGAN.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Granger at 9:12 p.m.

Motion by Novitke, seconded by Ketels, that all items on tonight's agenda be received, placed on file, and taken in order of appearance.

Motion carried by the following vote: Yes: Granger, Ketels, Novitke

No: None Absent: None

Discussion ensued regarding construction during 2011 season. The City Engineer provided an overview and updates on infrastructure inventory. Following discussion regarding pavement projects, the Committee asked for information from the City's Bond Counsel, Don Kiem and Mike Gormely, on various ways to finance pavement projects (dedicated millage, types of bonding, etc.) The City Engineer and Director of Public Works stated that immediate pavement projects total \$8,737,000, and at a minimum \$1,343,000 are critical and need to be done. The City Treasurer/Comptroller recommended a ballot proposal to restore the 20 mills authorized by City Charter, which was since rolled back by Headlee.

Discussion ensued regarding sewers (referencing the map from the earlier Committee-of-the-Whole meeting) and bonding for these projects. The City Engineer explained that the City must minimally complete half of \$6.5 Million of SRF funding to keep S2 funding (\$1 million.) The Chair would like to see a contingency plan established for funding.

# CONSTRUCTION COMMITTEE 06-13-11

There was a consensus of the Committee to ask Mr. Gormely to compute the debt repayment schedule for \$1.25 million to cover critical projects if necessary.

There was further discussion regarding identification of critical construction projects 2012-2017, and the Chair suggested this be discussed the next meeting date sometime in August.

Motion by Ketels, seconded by Novitke, that the meeting of the Construction Committee be adjourned at 10:08 p.m. PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
