## The next item on the agenda was concerning **Scheduling a Public Hearing regarding proposed amendments to Chapter 98, Zoning, Sections 98-202 and 98-242, Permitted Uses: Dancing.**

At this time, Assistant City Attorney C. Berschback presented to the Planning Commissioners an LCC guideline handout to differentiate between a dance permit, an entertainment permit, and a danceentertainment permit. A dancing permit would also affect a minor change to Chapter 50 relating to Liquor Licenses. A Planning Commission Workshop meeting will be scheduled prior to the next regular Planning Commission Meeting.

The next item on the agenda was regarding **Building Inspector's Monthly Report**. Mr. Tutag reported the following items of interest:

• A Redevelopment Ready Communities meeting is scheduled on Thursday, June 29<sup>th</sup> to discuss procedures. Mr. Tutag will update the Planning Commission at the next meeting.

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- Salvatore Scallopini has applied for a business license and is moving into the building vacated by Pizzeria Venti.
- Building Official Tutag and City Administrator Wollenweber attended a meeting at University of Liggett School regarding the Cook Road campus. Liggett used a 500' radius to notify neighbors regarding this meeting, which resulted with approximately 20 attending neighbors. A Planning Commission Workshop will be scheduled for the site plan review.
- Mack Avenue vacancies are at a phenomenal level (approx. 3.2%).
- Residential permits are steady.

The next item on the agenda was regarding Verbal Council Report, June – Vitale

On the June 5, 2006 Council Meeting, Commissioner Vitale reported a fence variance was denied, but other than that, there was nothing of relevance to the Planning Commission.

On the June 19, 2006 Council Meeting, Commissioner Hames reported for Commissioner Vitale and indicated the City Council approved a temporary Dog Park at the Lake Front Park and an application for a use variance for placement of a temporary trailer near the Mobil Station at Mack & Vernier was tabled to the next City Council meeting on July 10, 2006 so other ways to test the soil could be investigated.

The last item on the agenda was regarding **New Business**.

Mr. Tutag indicated a variance for a new business (Nail Tech) was also denied at the June 19<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting and that the property owner, Dr. Nesom, may decide to apply for re-zoning.

The City Council granted a variance in accordance with the Metro Act to NextG Network, which will allow the placement of 6-8 boxes to be unobtrusively installed on utility poles throughout the city. An existing pole with said equipment is presently located at Mack & Severn, on the west side of Mack.
