ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

- Aerosol cans
- Asbestos – containing materials
- Battery acid, fuel oil, gasoline, and petroleum solvents
- Brake and transmission fluids, coolants and radiator flushes
- Computers, laptops, monitors, mice, keyboards, computer parts, printers, faxes, scanners, cell phones, and mp3 players
- Expired medications (prescription or over-the-counter)
- Fluorescent lights
- Fungicides, herbicides, insecticides and fertilizer
- Furniture and metal polishes, floor care products
- Glues, adhesives and wood preservatives
- Household batteries
- Mercury
- Nail polish and remover
- Oven, drain and other household cleaners, bleaches and disinfectants
- Paint (oil base), stain, shellac, varnish, paint thinner/turpentine and paint removers
- Photographic chemicals
- Pool chemicals
- Rat poison
- Resins

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

- Commercially generated waste
- Compressed gas cylinders (includes propane and fire extinguishers)
- Containers greater than five (5) gallons in size
- Explosives, ammunition and shock-sensitive materials
- Medical waste such as needles
- **Paint (latex) – NOT hazardous waste, MUST be discarded with regular trash after it is dried out or solidified**
- Radioactive materials
- Smoke alarm (remove batteries for hazardous recycling and dispose of alarm in rubbish)

COMPLIMENTARY SHREDDING SERVICE

A mobile shredding truck will be on site at the DPW yard from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm on Saturday, October 19, 2024. Materials can be shredded without removing file folders, staples, rubber bands or paper clips. **Material for shredding must be in paper bags – boxed material will not be accepted. Each vehicle will be limited to four (4) paper grocery-size bags.** All material will be shredded before the truck leaves the DPW yard.
