RE: Roslyn Road Construction Update

Dear Resident:

The contractor is working on transferring water services onto the temporary water main in preparation for the final segment of pipe bursting. Weather permitting, the contractor is planning to pull the final segment of pipe from Goethe to Marter early next week. Once this final section of pipe bursting is completed, the hydrants will be installed and the final segment will be tested. Once the hydrant is installed, the contractor will proceed with transferring water services onto the new water main.

Please note that residents should never be out of water overnight. If you experience any unexpected water or sewer issues, please contact the contractor's superintendent, Bill, at (810) 343-1847.

Due to the construction, the city will be unable to collect leaves from the north side of the road. Please either place your leaves in bags or blow them to the south side of the road for collection.

As always, we apologize for any inconvenience this may create, and we appreciate your patience and understanding during construction.

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

Please place garbage, recycling and brush curbside by 7:00 a.m. as normal. Pickup will continue as normal until otherwise notified.

Please note, the contractor is responsible to maintain access for emergency vehicles throughout construction. However, in order to reduce the potential for incidents, the Public Safety Department has asked to please refrain from using fire pits and chimneys during construction.
