## RE: Roslyn Road Construction Update

Dear Resident:

Weather permitting, road work on Roslyn Road is expected to resume the week starting April 1<sup>st</sup>. During the first week of construction the contract will begin mobilizing equipment and materials and will begin pavement sawcutting and storm sewer repairs.

During the storm sewers repairs, traffic will not be able to pass while a trench is open across the road. However, access for residents to the road and driveways will remain available on either side of the repair areas. These isolated, temporary closures are expected to be in place only during the work day. Once the sewers are installed, the excavation will be filled in and restored to traffic.

The following week, once the storm sewer repairs are completed, the contractor will shut down the north side of the road and maintain one-way traffic eastbound on the south side of the road. The contractor will begin removing the curb and drive approaches on the north side of the road from Mack to Marter and on the south side from Marter to Goethe. Residents on the north side of the road from Mack to Marter and on the south side from Marter to Goethe will need to remove vehicles from driveways prior to the start of removals. Further notice will be provided prior to loss of driveway access.

As always, we apologize for any inconvenience this may create, and we appreciate your patience and understanding during construction.

## **GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS**

Please place garbage, recycling and brush curbside by 7:00 a.m. as normal. Pickup will continue as normal until otherwise notified.

Please note, the contractor is responsible to maintain access for emergency vehicles throughout construction. However, in order to reduce the potential for incidents, the Public Safety Department has asked to please refrain from using fire pits and chimneys during construction.
