RE: Roslyn Road Construction Update

Dear Resident:

On Monday, April 8, the contractor began working on removals. Weather permitting, the contractor will continue removing the curb and drive approaches on the north side of the road from Marter to Mack and on the south side from Mack to Goethe. If your driveway is within these limits of removal, please remove your vehicle from driveways by 7:00 a.m. on Monday morning. The contractor will continue placing temporary gravel to maintain your driveway access until the time comes to grade and prep for new concrete.

In the event that your vehicle is displaced overnight and you have to park on adjacent streets, it is recommended that you place a piece of paper with your address between your car's sun visor and windshield to assist with the Public Safety as they relax parking enforcement.

As always, we apologize for any inconvenience this may create, and we appreciate your patience and understanding during construction.

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

Please place garbage, recycling and brush curbside by 7:00 a.m. as normal. Pickup will continue as normal until otherwise notified.

Please note, the contractor is responsible to maintain access for emergency vehicles throughout construction. However, in order to reduce the potential for incidents, the Public Safety Department has asked to please refrain from using fire pits and chimneys during construction.

If you have any concerns or special needs during construction, please contact the onsite representative from the City's Consultant Anderson, Eckstein and Westrick, Inc. (AEW).
