RE: Roslyn Road Construction Update

Dear Resident:

The contractor has continued preparing the base for the upcoming curb and gutter work. Weather permitting, the curb and gutter is scheduled to begin tomorrow and continue on Monday, May 6. If your home is affected by the new curb and gutter work, please remove your vehicles from driveways by 7:00 a.m. tomorrow morning.

The driveway work will begin after the curb and gutter work is completed. Once the concrete work begins it will be approximately 2 weeks before access to driveways can be restored. If your driveway is affected, please continue parking on adjacent side streets. It is recommended that you place a piece of paper with your address between your car's sun visor and windshield to assist with the Public Safety as they relax parking enforcement.

As always, we apologize for any inconvenience this may create, and we appreciate your patience and understanding during construction.

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

Please place garbage, recycling and brush curbside by 7:00 a.m. as normal. Pickup will continue as normal until otherwise notified.

Please note, the contractor is responsible to maintain access for emergency vehicles throughout construction. However, in order to reduce the potential for incidents, the Public Safety Department has asked to please refrain from using fire pits and chimneys during construction.

If you have any concerns or special needs during construction, please contact the onsite representative from the City's Consultant Anderson, Eckstein and Westrick, Inc. (AEW).
